

Our veterinarians will work with you to determine what vaccines and preventative care schedule is best for your puppy, based on their age, breed and lifestyle. In general, our hospital follows the American Animal Hospital Association (AAHA)'s most recent canine vaccination guidelines to help provide a solid foundation for your puppy's preventative healthcare. The following chart outlines our general recommendations for canine patients.

6-8 months	Spay/Neuter procedure Microchip	Pre-operative bloodwork	
1st-3rd annual exams	DHPP or DHLPP (3 years) Bordetella (annually) Rabies (1 or 3 year) Leptospirosis (annually)	Fecal examination Heartworm test	Continue flea, tick and heartworm prevention year round!
4-6th annual exams	DHPP or DHLPP (3 years) Bordetella (annually) Rabies (1 or 3 year) Leptospirosis (annually)	Fecal examination Heartworm test Young Wellness bloodwork screening	Continue flea, tick and heartworm prevention year round!
7th annual exam and onward	DHPP or DHLPP (3 years) Bordetella (annually) Rabies (1 or 3 year) Leptospirosis (annually)	Fecal examination Heartworm test Senior bloodwork screening (including UA and thyroid)	Continue flea, tick and heartworm prevention year round!
